The Powder King Mountain Resort is an all-season destination ski resort that offers over 900 acres of skiable terrain, 37 runs, three lifts and over 40 feet of annual average snowfall. The area is world renowned for snow consistency and quality as it is ranked #4 in North America and #1 in Canada for snow.

The Resort has a Master Plan Agreement with the Province which allows for base area development ongoing build out of services and residential/hotel development. There is a three phase development plan which allows for land acquisitions, real estate development, commercial development, ski runs, lifts, and summer recreation activities.


Azouzetta Lake Resort

Azouzetta Lake, at an elevation of 876m, is located in the Hart Range of the Northern Rockies of British Columbia

The lake lodge is located six kilometers north of the Powder King ski hill. The lodge offers accommodation year-round and is situated on the pristine 340 acre lake. The resort has several A-frame cabins including 18 private units as well as RV sites, summer camping, a manager's residence and convenience store. The lake supports rainbow trout and an array of natural wildlife as well as numerous recreational opportunities such as kayaking, canoeing and boating as well as mountain biking, hiking, and other pursuits nearby.






